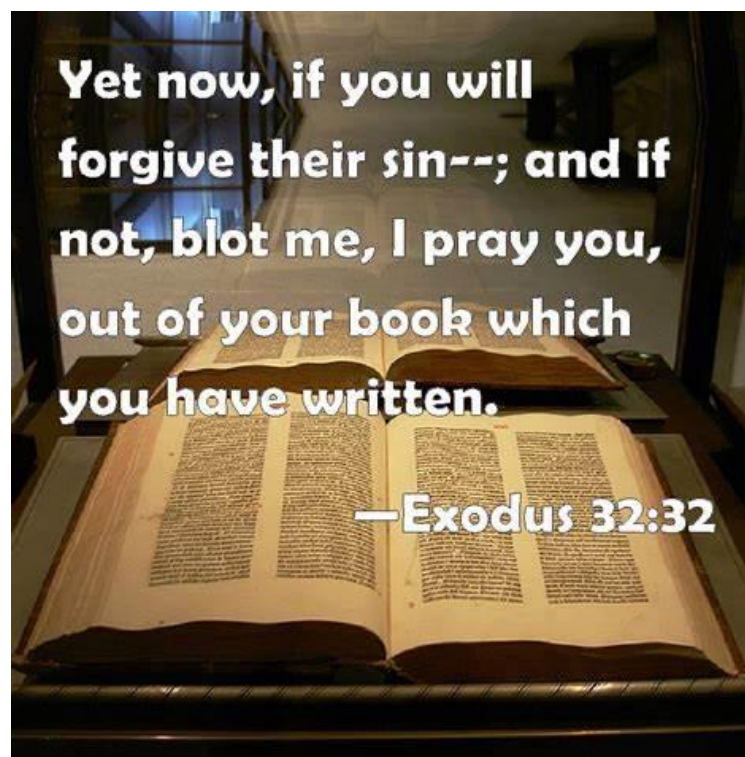
Welcome Guests! We are glad you have joined us this morning! Please stop by the Information Booth for a special Guest Pack and coffee mug.
